

GENERAL TIPS & SHORTCUTS (WONDERSHARE FILMORA9)

Note: Generally speaking you use the CTRL key on PC keyboards and CMD on Mac, so I've represented it here as CMD/CTRL (eg. CMD/CTRL Z would be CMD Z on a Mac, or CTRL Z on a PC). Use whichever is relevant to your computer.

Double click on clip thumbnails in the browser window to see them in the preview window.

CMD/CTRL Z to undo anything

UP and DOWN arrow keys to get playhead to go to beginning or end of a clip.
BACKWARD or FORWARD arrow to move frame by frame through the clip.

MARKING UP VIDEO CLIPS IN THE BROWSER

Space bar = play/start playback

i to mark in-point

o to mark out-point

Drag the video clip from your viewer screen to timeline and it will just drag the selected bit with i and o.

A tick will appear in browser window on video showing you have used part of the clip in the video project.

TRIMMING IN THE TIMELINE

CMD/CTRL + or - to zoom in (+) or out (-) on your timeline.

Or drag time line left or right on the white meter bar at top

Or use the - + slider on top rhs of time line

Grab the end the clip and drag it in or out to add or remove material.

To delete a clip in the timeline, click on it to select and press the backspace key.

To change the position of a clip in the timeline, click on it and drag it to the new position.

To move a number of clips at once, click and drag across the clips to select and then click and drag.

To cut a whole section of your clip, or add an edit point, place your playhead (the vertical red line with scissors icon) at the relevant point and click on the scissors to add an edit point. The material on either side of the edit point will now be treated as separate clips. To delete either clip, click on it to select and press the backspace key.
